NOTICE OF RACE

The Club Náutico Altea together with the IFDCO have the pleasure of inviting members of the International Flying Dutchman Class Organisation to participate In the

International Flying Dutchman 2005 EuroFlyingCup

which will be held at Altea, Spain from 3rd to 5th February 2005. The Organising Authority is the Club Náutico Altea and RFEV. The event will be conducted on the waters of Altea.

1. Rules

The event will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2001–2004, the current Flying Dutchman class rules and IFDCO Championship rules.

The International Flying Dutchman 2005 EuroFlyingCup are classified Category "C" in accordance with the ISAF Advertising Code (RRS Appendix 1) as restricted by the IFDCO Class Rule 119.

Competitors may be required to display Event sponsors name(s)/logo(s) and bow numbers. If required, the Organising Authority will supply these items and they shall be affixed and/or worn as prescribed in the Sailing Instructions.

The Organising Authority reserves the right to refuse advertising by a boat or competitor when it is in conflict with the laws of the Spanish government.

2. Eligibility and Entry

2.1 The Event is open to all boats of the International Flying Dutchman Class.

2.2 The Event is open to all those who are fully paid up members of IFDCO. Each boat must have at least one Full Member and one Associate Member sailing in it. Membership Cards must be presented at Registration.

2.3 Eligible boats may enter on official Entry Form which shall be lodged with the Organising Authority or through the official electronic form on the event website. The fully completed entry form must be received at the entry address not later than 23rd January 2005 accompanied by the required fee (entry fee). Entries may be accepted after the closing date at the discretion of the Organising Authority.

3. Fees

Entry fees are stated in 100 €. All entries will receive a competitors pack at registration.

The entry fee shall be transfer to the account number below named to the Club Náutico Altea not later than 23rd January 2005.

4. Schedule of Events

Everyday the organization will provide to all the crews with a picnic bag, containing water, sandwiches and fruits.

On Saturday February 5th there will be no starting signal later than 15.00.

5. Sailing Instructions

The sailing Instructions will be available not later than 24th January 2005 on the official website of the Club Náutico Altea (www.cnaltea.com). They will also be available at registration.

6. Racing Area

The racing area will be on the waters of Altea Bay in the vicinity of Altea Harbour.

7. Courses

The courses will be Triangular as described in the sailing instructions.

8. Scoring

The Low Point scoring system, Appendix A 4.1 will apply

There are 7 races programmed. If 4 or more races are completed there will be one discard.

9. Penalties

RRS 44.2 - 720 Turns Penalty will apply.

10. Support Boats

Team Managers, Coaches and other support personnel shall keep at least 100 m clear of the course area during racing except when asked to assist by the Race Committee.

All support and coach boats shall prominently display an identification flag (white with black letters 600mm hoist by 600mm fly) bearing the three-letter code or the Nationality Flag of the competitor's nation that they are supporting.

11. Radio Communications

A boat shall neither make radio transmission while racing nor receive radio communication not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones. The use of electronic devices is forbidden and includes GPS, radio and telephones.

12. Prizes

The following prizes will be awarded:

- EuropaCup will be presented to 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th places
- The Ladies Prize. First lady in overall results.

Additional prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the Organising Authority.

13. Rights To Use Name and Likeness

In participating in the event a competitor automatically grants to the Organising Authority and the sponsors of the event the right, in perpetuity to make use, and show from time to time and at their discretion any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or film television and any other such reproductions of him/her during the period of the competition for the said event in which the competitor participates and in all material related to the said event without compensation.

14. Entry Disclaimer

It is the competitor's decision whether to enter the Event or to start and continue in any race. Competitors shall accept that their participation in an event is at their exclusive risk in every respect. Refer RRS Rule 4, Decision to Race.

The Organising Authority and the Club Náutico Altea, their officers, members servants and agents, accept no liability in respect of loss of life personal injury or loss or damage to property which maybe sustained by reason of their participation or intended participation in an event or how so ever arising in connection with an event.

15. Buoyancy

All competitors shall wear personal flotation devices at all times whilst racing. The devices should be in good condition and in accordance with the current specifications issued or approved by a National Authority affiliated to the International Sailing Federation, or a Standards Organisation or Certification Authority recognised for that purpose by its respective government. Attention is drawn to RRS Fundamental Rule 1.2.

16. Substitute Helmsperson/Crew

Either the Helmsperson or crew may be substituted before the first race after informing the Jury in writing. Or after the first race provided that approval in writing has been obtained from the Jury.

17. Accommodation

The organization will offer **free accommodation** for the sailors (with the limit of the first 40 entries) from February 2nd to 5th.

Special price offers will be available for other non-sailing people and for the days before and after the event.
