AT LAKE "LOOSDRECHT" FOR

**THE STAR, FLYING DUTCHMAN, CONTENDER, FINN, LASER, LASER MASTER, LASER RADIAL, ,
SOLO, 420, 470 and Pampus Class.**

Organised by the Royal Yacht Club "Loosdrecht" (KWVL)

1. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of the Royal Netherlands Yachting Union (KNWV) to the RRS, the relevant Class Rules, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions. The Sailing Instructions may alter the rules in this Notice of Race.

2. Entries

Eligible boats may be entered by completing registration with the organising authority. Registration is through the website of the KWVL : www.kwvl.nl.

2.2 Entry closing date: March 15th, 2008.

2.3 Boats not having registered before the closing date may not enter the Easter Regatta.

2.3 If no more than 10 boats have entered in a particular class before the closing date, the Race Committee may decide to cancel the races for that particular class.

2.4 The entry fee is €35,-- for the Finn, Laser, Laser Master, Laser Radial, Solo and Contender; €45,-- for the Star, FD, 470, 420 and Pampus class. The entry fee must be paid cash on registration.

3 Changes in the Class Rules

No changes in the class rules will be made.

4 Sailing Instructions

The sailing instructions are available at the Regatta Office from March 21st at 17:00 hrs till 19.00 hours and on Saturday March 22nd starting at 09.00 hours.

5 Registration and Racing Schedule

Registration of competitors will take place on March 21st from 17.00 till 19.00 hrs and on March 22nd from 09.00 hrs. until 10.30 hrs.

The starting order of the classes for the first start of the day is:

Star, FD, 470, Finn, Contender, Pampus, Laser, Laser Master, Laser Radial, Solo

Depending on the number of entries, the start of the Laser, the Laser Master and the Laser Radial may be combined.

Rule 26 (RRS) will be applied. The time between the warning signal and the starting signal is 5 minutes.

The races are scheduled as follows:

Time of the warning signal of the first starting class:

1	March 22 nd , 2008	11:00
2	March 22 nd , 2008	As soon as possible after race 1
3	March 23 rd , 2008	11:00
4	March 23 rd , 2008	As soon as possible after race 3
5	March 24 th , 2008	11:00

No starts will be made on March 24th after 14:00 hrs.

6 Course

The course configuration will be a classical lake course, around the fixed buoys at Lake Loosdrecht, whereby the first windward mark will be an inflatable buoy. Due to local circumstances the length of the course may vary.

7 Scoring

The Series will be scored as provided in Appendix A of the RRS using the Low Point Scoring System. If 5 races have been completed the worst score in a race will be excluded.

8 Prizes

Prizes will be awarded to each member of the crew as follows: 10-20 boats 4 prizes, 21 or more boats 5 prizes. For the Flying Dutchman class and the Finn class Challenge prizes in the form of a large Easter Egg containing a half model of the class in question are presented to the winning crew. Another type of half-model will be presented as challenge prize to the winner in the Star class. All challenge prizes will remain at the Royal Loosdrecht Yacht Club.
