POINTS SYSTEM

<p>World Cup points (WCP) are awarded to each helmsman that takes part in a qualifying event.</p> <p>A qualifying event must consist of at least 3 races and a minimum number of competitors.</p>	<p>$WCP = P \times WCF$</p> <p>$WCF = S \times Q$</p> <p>6 events with highest WCP count</p>														
<p>Points are awarded based on the overall finishing position (P points); number of starters (S factor) and number of top helmsmen taking part (Q factor)</p>	<p>P - Position Points:</p> <p>Less than 50 starters $P=51-R$ 50+ starters $P=(Starters+1 - R) \times 50 / Starters$</p> <p>R is overall finishing position.</p>														
<p>The Quality factor can only be calculated after the Ranking list for the previous year has been finalised.</p>	<p>Q - Quality Factor</p> <p>$Q = (W + 1275) / 1275$</p> <p>W is total points of helmsmen taking part where winner of previous years ranking list has 50 points, 2nd - 49 points and 50th placed helm has 1 point</p>
